Responsible for training of staff on each piece of equipment regarding proper usage, safety features, etc. to comply with all safety regulations.

Course Description: The greens, tees and fairways are bentgrass/*poa annua* mix. The irrigation system is Rainbird Cirrus.

Job Description/Essential Functions

Responsibilities and Duties:

Supervises and schedules work for golf course equipment and mechanics.

Oversees mechanics, manages repairs and maintenance along with diagnoses and repairs of mechanical failures of entire golf maintenance fleet. This includes but is not limited to all mowers, carts, sprayers, aerifiers, tillers, grinders, trucks, tractors, sweepers, rollers, small handheld equipment and other equipment used in utility work to ensure the course is maintained up to the Country Club of York standards.



Job Description/Essential Functions—continued

Responsibilities and Duties:

Instructs and/or trains golf course maintenance workers regarding preventive maintenance, the proper cleaning of and safe operation of equipment.

Prioritizes equipment repair and maintenance work.

Maintains a preventive maintenance program within budget on all equipment, and purchases repair parts and replacement supplies.

Maintains and updates all records for equipment and parts inventory purchases, equipment conditions, costs of repairs and preventive maintenance for all equipment.

Spot checks equipment for performance on the course, frequently makes emergency repairs to equipment on the course, and services or supervises servicing of equipment prior to use.

Ability to fabricate necessary items (tools, parts, etc.) for equipment and equipment maneuverability.

Oversees the shop area maintenance, cleanliness and safe working conditions.

Works with local and national distributors to enhance our new Toro equipment package.

Must be available to work early mornings, weekends, daytimes and evenings, based on operational needs.

Minimal travel required to attend industry events, etc.

Regular attendance required based on business expectations and needs.

Ensures compliance with all federal, state and local employment laws, safety regulations and guidelines.

Other duties as assigned by the supervisor/manager or other management of The Club.

Educational Requirements:

Associates Degree, Bachelor's Degree or Foreign Equivalency in Mechanical Engineering or related field desired.

Experience Requirements.

Fluent oral and written English communication skills.

Working knowledge of light and heavy maintenance equipment and automotive apparatuses.

Skilled in the use of a variety of equipment repair tools and the making of various types of mechanical repairs. Ability to diagnose mechanical troubles and determine appropriate maintenance work.

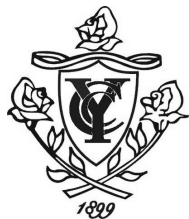
Working knowledge of the theory, care, and operation of internal combustion engines and mowing equipment.
